

"I pray that my daughter and family grow stronger from this."

These are the words Dana spoke at the sentencing hearing for the man who abused her daughter.

"Though [Harper's] innocence was taken and she was violated, I have to continue to make sure she has a childhood she remembers as happy – not full of scary thoughts, anxiety, and not being able to trust people. I pray that my daughter and family grow stronger from this."

Harper was just seven years old when she was sexually abused by a family friend. Like many children, she was afraid and kept the abuse a secret for more than a year. When Dana learned of the abuse, "it took probably 20 minutes to process what [she] had just been told."

The following days and months were a "whirlwind" of phone calls, appointments, and court appearances. That's when Dana and Harper walked through the doors of Family & Children's Place.


