Every Child Deserves to Reach Their Full Potential

Greater Louisville Head Start is one of three prevention programs offered by Family & Children's Place. Working in partnership with Community Coordinated Child Care (4-C), this free program serves nearly 550 families each year.

HOW DOES HEAD START HELP FAMILIES?

- Enhance each child's growth and development
- Strengthen parents' ability to nurture their child
- Connect families with needed community services
- Provide children with educational, health, and nutritional services

WHO CAN ENROLL IN HEAD START?

Early Head Start serves eligible children from birth through age 3, while Head Start serves eligible children from ages 3 to 5.

DOES HEAD START SERVE CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES OR SPECIAL NEEDS?

Yes! Both Early Head Start and Head Start are inclusive of children and families with disabilities and/or special needs.

WHERE IS HEAD START OFFERED?

Early Head Start is offered through two convenient options: daily programs at learning centers around Louisville or weekly home visits. Head Start is offered only at learning centers.

Harper was just seven years old when she was sexually abused by a family friend. Like many children, she was afraid and kept the abuse a secret for more than a year.

When her mom, Dana, learned of the abuse, "it took probably 20 minutes to process what [she] had just been told."

The following days and months were a "whirlwind" of phone calls, appointments, and court appearances. That's when Dana and Harper f rst walked through our doors.

Family & Children's Place gave Harper a safe place to tell her story so the perpetrator could be held accountable. We also gave her the compassionate counseling she needed to lead a happy, healthy life.

Today, Harper and her family are thriving. They credit so much of this

progress to the services they received at Family & Children's Place.

Harper's story is more common than any of us want to believe. In 2018, nearly 50,000 children in Kentucky and Indiana were abused or neglected.

We know one of the many tragic consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic is that countless children have been confined to unsafe homes. Reports of abuse and neglect have dropped drastically, but we have every reason to believe children still are in danger.

Family & Children's Place has stood strong in 2020 – giving thousands of children like Harper the priceless, irreplaceable gifts of *justice* and *healing*.

We believe children like Harper should be seen and heard and believed, and we know you agree. Please help us stay standing for every single child who will need us in 2021.

Clare is 7 years old. Not long after the COVID-19 pandemic began, Clare's world was turned upside down. Authorities had begun investigating a family member on suspicion of possessing child sex images and sexually abusing Clare.

Clare and her sisters were brought to Family & Children's Place to be seen by the caring, compassionate, and highly-trained staff at our Kosair Charities Child Advocacy Center. Our team conducted special interviews for use by law enforcement, connected Clare's mom with legal and counseling resources, and ensured Clare and her sisters would be safe while the investigation continued.

As they drove away from Family & Children's Place, Clare kept asking her mom about her favorite part of the day. Clare's mom just wanted to cry. It had been a grueling day – every mother's worst nightmare. But Clare said it was her "best day ever."


How could a child say such a thing?

Well, Clare and her sisters got to play with Emmie, our facility dog, throughout the day. They received stuffed animals for comfort and blankets when they needed to rest. They ate lunch, played with our staff, and even got to take home their Play-Doh – all at no cost to their family.

Clare's Story (cont.)

Our world-class child advocacy centers are front-line responders to more than 1,100 cases of suspected child abuse and neglect each year. In fact, we are the only organization in Louisville and Southern Indiana that coordinates the efforts of child protection staff, law enforcement professionals, prosecutors, medical experts, and mental health clinicians – all under one roof.

Our doors have remained open throughout the COVID-19 pandemic for Clare and hundreds of children just like her.

Prevent

They say an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure. We couldn't agree more! Despite the pandemic, our HANDS program has conducted **1,516 "visits"** – by phone instead of in homes – with new and expectant parents. Meanwhile, our school-based services team is making regular wellness checks by phone and dropping off care packages to more than **35 vulnerable families**.



Stop

For far too many children, home is not a safe place – *especially* during the pandemic. Our child advocacy centers are first responders to child abuse and neglect, and we took immediate precautions in order to continue seeing clients. In fact, we've conducted **interviews with**63 children since the pandemic began. Our doors will always remain open so that we can serve these children in need.



Heal

When a child has been abused or neglected, hope may seem too far gone for both the child and their family. This is where our counseling services enter the equation. Our team of licensed counselors use proven techniques to reignite hope where it once was lost. Despite the pandemic, our team has provided 410 counseling sessions and 824 case management sessions – all by phone!


